Process Checklist

Step 1: Complete Application

___ Complete all applicable portions of the application and return it to the school office accompanied by the following:

- Application fee due when application is submitted, non-refundable
- SC Immunization Certificate
- Copy of Child's Birth Certificate
- Most Recent Report Card
- Copies of any psychological evaluations administered to your child
- Covenant Admission Application - Teacher Reference (Yellow Insert)
- Covenant Admission Application - Pastor Recommendation Form (Ivory Insert)

Step 2: Assist Covenant in Obtaining Necessary Information

___ Covenant Classical Christian School will request school records including the most current report card, standardized test scores, and discipline records from the school your child most recently attended. You may wish to follow-up with the school to make sure we receive these records in a timely manner. Under normal circumstances, these records must be sent from the previous school directly to Covenant. Hand delivered records will not be considered official records.

Step 3: Complete Placement Testing and Interview

___ Once all application materials are received, our office will contact you to schedule the placement testing and your family interview. All interviews are conducted by our Head Administrator.

(Please Note- Covenant will not schedule the testing/interview until all application materials have been received and reviewed.)

Step 4: Finalize Registration

___ Upon acceptance of your child to Covenant Classical Christian School, you must sign and complete the enrollment contract. Placement in classes does not happen until the enrollment contract has been signed and registration fee has been paid. Space is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

The Bible is the inspired, inerrant Word of God as contained in the 66 books of the Old and New Testaments. It is the written record of God's supernatural revelation of Himself to men, absolute in its authority, complete in its revelation, final in its content, and without any errors in its original manuscripts (2 Timothy 3:16,17).

God created the heavens and the earth, and everything contained therein, according to its kind, directly by the power of His word (Genesis 1). He created humankind directly and personally as a unique creation, making one male and one female, giving them to one another in marriage, and thus establishing His created design for human gender and sexuality (Genesis 2:4-25; Matthew 19:4-6).

All men in their natural state are lost, alienated from God, and spiritually dead (Ephesians 2:1, 5). "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).

Salvation comes only by grace, a free gift of God, through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, who died for our sins according to the Scriptures (Corinthians 15:3). Those who, chosen by God, receive Christ by faith have their sins forgiven (Ephesians 1:4-7), their hearts cleansed (Acts 15:9), are born of the Spirit, become children of God (John 1: 12,13) and are made new creatures in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17).

God is One God (Deuteronomy 6:4), Who exists in Three Persons (Genesis 1:26): Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19). Jesus Christ, as the Scriptures affirm, is the Son of God (Matthew 16:16) and Son of Man, was born of a virgin (Luke 1:27, 31), and is Himself very God (Titus 2:13). The Scriptures also declare the deity and personality of the Holy Spirit (John 4:24).

Our Lord Jesus rose from the dead in the same body that was laid to rest in the tomb (John 20:25-27). The bodies of all believers who die will be raised from the dead and they will receive an incorruptible body like unto His glorious body (1 Corinthians 15:53; Philippians 3:21). All other men will be raised to "resurrection of judgment" (John 5:28, 29).

Christians, God's new creations by the work of the Holy Spirit (John 3:8), are called to live all their lives in obedience to the precepts of God's Word (Psalm 119:105). Salvation is unto holiness (Ephesians 1:4; 2:8-10) and the ordinary fruit of a believer's life is to be practical holiness, defined by a desire to keep the law of God as a continuing expression of gratitude for the great salvation (Ephesians 5:8-10), submission to God's word as the only rule for life and faith (Proverbs 3:5), and repentance when convicted of sin as defined by the Scriptures (1 John 1:6-9).

Christian living includes not only witnessing with words and deeds the gospel of Christ, but also doing work and, indeed, everything to the glory of God (1 Corinthians 10:31).

Jesus Christ will come again on earth the second time (Hebrews 9:38); personally (Acts 1:11; 1 Thessalonians 4:16); bodily (Acts 1:11; Colossians 2:9); visibly (Matthew 26:64; Revelation 1:7).
