

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students have the option of completing two distinct diploma programs. Students seeking a Classical Diploma must earn a minimum grade-point average of 2.0 and complete the requirements for the curricular program for a Classical Diploma. Students graduating with an Advanced Classical Diploma must earn a minimum grade-point average of 2.5 and complete the curricular program for the Advanced Classical Diploma. Courses in *italics* are being transitioned into the curricular program. Students seeking to earn an Advanced Classical Diploma must have completed course work from a classical Christian school. Approved course work is at the discretion of the Headmaster.
